





Pascua Yaqui Tribe Tucson COVID-19 Testing and Results Report March – April of 2020


1. Graph below shows **ONLY** testing done by The Pascua Yaqui Tribe Health Services Division (PYTHSD). These results **DO NOT** show the testing done at Pascua Yaqui El Rio Clinic and or other facilities that our tribal members may use.




2. Graphs below shows 16 confirmed COVID-19 positive cases. 4 positive cases were collected by the PYTHSD and 12 positive cases were reported by other agencies in Tucson. The 156 negative results only reflect the testing that was done by the PYTHSD and **DOES NOT** include the number of negative results collected by other agencies in Tucson that are testing for COVID-19.



3. The graph below shows twelve positive cases that are currently in recovery, two positive cases that are hospitalized and two deaths related to COVID-19. This data set was reported by other agencies in Tucson that are testing for COVID-19.




4. Graph below shows positive cases for members living on and off the reservation. There are 2 positive cases from individuals living on The Pascua Yaqui Pueblo and 14 positive cases of individuals living off The Pascua Yaqui Pueblo. This data set includes testing collected by PYTHSD and other agencies that are testing for Covid-19 in Tucson.

6. Graph below shows the demographics for COVID-19. Out of the sixteen confirmed positive cases, 6 are male and 10 are female. This data set includes data from PYTHSD and other agencies testing for Covid-19 in Tucson.



7. Graph below shows the age ranges of positive COVID-19 cases. There are zero confirmed cases for individuals under the age of 18. One confirmed case from the age range of 19-29. Nine confirmed cases from individuals between the ages of 30-50. Four confirmed cases from individuals between the ages of 51-60. Two Confirmed cases from individuals over 61. Data includes numbers collected from PYTHSD and other agencies testing for Covid-19 in Tucson.
